Apologies and thank you for identifying these discrepancies. The issue with original tables for hospitalizations and deaths was related to an underly coding error that was not caught on our end before the data went out. Please know that the team responsible for this reporting will be meeting to review the reporting process and to instate better quality control processes for this request and other reporting.

The table with **case data** has not been updated. The comparison number from the web below includes out of state cases which are not included in the tables we are providing here. Additionally, there are historical corrections which explain additional fluctuation over time. Please note, the attached tables only include breakthrough cases that were confirmed with the RICAIR vaccine data base. With this week's web update we will begin reporting breakthrough cases and vaccine status based either on RICAIR records or information gathered through the case interview process. When we update this table next month it will reflect the new reporting method.

Again, I want to apologize for this error and thank you for bringing it to our attention. Please let us know if you have any additional questions.
