

Examination of the heart by a cardiovascular pathologist shows focal lymphocytic myocarditis involving the cardiac conduction system; it is believed that the decedent was at risk for a sudden cardiac arrhythmia/event, and that it is likely that such an event preceded/contributed to the drowning of the decedent. Comprehensive toxicology testing was positive for alcohol (may in part or whole represent a postmortem artifact of decomposition). The manner of death is
